- I. CALL TO ORDER of the WHITE RIVER HEALTH DISTRICT BOARD of DIRECTORS MEETING
The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Sue Knapp, at 9:02.
- II. INTRODUCTION OF PARTICIPANTS: Participants on the call were identified.
- III. APPROVE LOAN AGREEMENT BY WRHD BOARD OF DIRECTORS:
 - Sue reviewed the loan commitment letter from Old West Federal Credit Union, noting the terms and conditional requirements of the owner. She explained certain aspects of the \$1.5M loan and the benefits and specifics of going with a conventional credit union loan versus a federal USDA loan. A primary purpose of this meeting was for both the District Board and the Foundation Board, in separate meetings, to approve the loan terms and conditions and indicate the respective authorized signer for both. Minutes of this meeting will meet one of the conditional requirements. For the purposes of this loan, the District is the 'Borrower'. There were no significant questions. Motions were made in two parts.
 - Motion was made by Jim Holycross to approve the loan terms with Old West Federal Credit Union and the required conditions as specified in a commitment letter from Jill Parker. Andrew Houck seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All ayes. Motion carried.
 - Motion was made by Jim Holycross to approve Sue Knapp as the authorized signatory for the White River Health District. Laura Taylor seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All ayes. Motion carried.
- IV. APPROVE NEW SIGNATURE AUTHORITIES:
 - Rivermark Credit Union: Sue explained the need to augment the authorized signatures for Rivermark by adding our FNP, Maddy Lawrence. Adding Maddy provides for 3 authorized signatories (Sue, Kim, Maddy).
 - Motion was made by Laura Taylor to add Maddy Lawrence as the third signer on the Rivermark account. Jim Holycross seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All ayes. Motion carried.
 - Community Bank: Sue explained the need to not add Kim Hahn as the third signatory (Kim had not completed the bank required paperwork so she had not officially been added; but minutes need to reflect the change in direction). Jim Holycross will be added as the third signatory. Signatories for the Community Bank Checking and Savings accounts would then be: Nina Marvin, Sue Knapp and Jim Holycross.
 - Motion was made by Jim Holycross to add himself as the third signer and not add Kim Hahn to the Community Bank checking and savings accounts. Laura Taylor seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All ayes. Motion carried.
